I. Conduct Toward the Onion

- 1. Never peel without purpose.
- 2. Do not refrigerate the Sacred Onion unless instructed by a Corebound Agent.
- 3. Crying is permitted. Wailing is performative.
- 4. Never mock an onion's size or scent. That's Layer-ism.
- 5. You may not name an onion "Jeff" more than once.

II. Interpersonal Etiquette

- 6. Always greet fellow members with "May your core remain unspoiled."
- 7. Refusing to complete the greeting is an act of Shallotry.
- 8. Disputes are settled via the Peel Duel: 3 rounds, 1 onion, no sauces.
- 9. Do not question another's Layer unless you are 2 Layers higher.
- 10. Garlic-sympathizers must self-report immediately.

III. On Ritual Protocol

- 11. Do not perform more than 3 rituals per solar day.
- 12. Improvised rituals must be documented in the Book of Steam.
- 13. All candlelight ceremonies must be approved by a Fry-Sentinel.
- 14. You may not reuse ritual shallots. Ever.
- 15. Layer transitions must be accompanied by a shedding gesture.

IV. On Secrecy and Containment

- 16. You may speak of The Layered only to those you've Onion-Marked.
- 17. Do not post the Bloom Coordinates on social media.
- 18. If interrogated, say: "I sell soup." Then vanish.
- 19. Do not let outsiders touch the Core Sigil.
- 20. All documents must be written in either code or cursive.

V. Infractions and Demotions

- 21. Mocking the bloom is grounds for peeling.
- 22. Serving raw leeks without permission is a Rank Violation.
- 23. Attempting to create "onion-based NFTs" is a permanent ban.
- 24. Wearing more than one Guardian pin is considered arrogance and punished with forced caramelization.

Other:

When doing a mission, please do the following:

Keep things removable (sticky notes, chalk, printed cards)

Keep all objects in your possession unless you have permission

Make it feel like art or absurd performance, not sabotage

If questioned, say "it's for a surreal art experiment about identity"
